Key stage 1 BEHAVIOUR REWARDS AND CODES



GOLD REWARDS

We want to celebrate your good behaviour with:

Celebration certificate Stickers

Praise House points
Special privileges and activities Special time

If you choose to behave unacceptably you will receive a code:

CODE ORANGE

You will be given a verbal warning first.

If you repeat it in a session you will be given a code orange which will be recorded.

This will be for any of the following:

- Calling out at the wrong time
- · Talking at the wrong time
- Making silly noises
- Not working/participating in a group
- · Interfering with other's learning
- Not being in the right place at the right time
- Interrupting

If you get three oranges in a week you will get a playtime detention.

CODE BLUE

This is serious. You will be given a code blue if you already have a code orange and repeat the same behaviour in a session. It will also be given for any of the following:

- Unkindness
- Name calling/swearing/ inappropriate language
- Misusing property
- Answering back or speaking rudely to any adult
- Hurting others or being spiteful
- Goading/winding others up
- Stealing from others
- Not telling the truth
- Ignoring any adult's instructions
- Behaving in a dangerous way that could cause harm to others, deliberately or otherwise

For each code blue, you will have a playtime detention. You will stand in the blue zone, and you won't be allowed to play with your friends. You will fill out a 'code blue' incident form and a letter will be sent home to your parents.

If you get three code blues in a half term you will lose special times.

CODE PURPLE

This is very serious. You will have to work for the whole lesson in another class. The head teacher and your parents will be informed. You will lose a privilege.

- Repeating code blue behaviour
- Physical /threatening aggression
- Severely disrupting lessons/bullying/swearing to insult/fighting/disrespecting adults

CODE RED

<u>This is extremely serious.</u> The head teacher and your parents will be informed. It <u>will</u> lead to an internal exclusion and may lead to an external exclusion.

- Repeating code purple behaviour
- Planned violence /abuse/major theft/ vandalism/ racism/ persistent bullying/ homophobic language
- Physical aggression or swearing towards any member of staff
