Each request is reviewed: we look to see if a holiday has been requested before and the child's overall attendance. All term time holiday will be unauthorised (POL is different). All holiday requests can be referred to the County Attendance Team and they will decide if a fine should be issued. Time missed off school impacts on your child's education; the way things are taught, a whole unit of work can be missed if away for a week.
