Dear Parents/Carers,

You should have already received details of your child's induction appointment time and their staggered transition into school. If you have not yet received this information, or are unsure of your appointment time, please do contact the school office, via email (office@nap-walt.bucks.sch.uk).

Induction meeting

To enable us to meet you face to face, for your child's induction appointment, we are putting the following protocols in place:

- On the day of your child's appointment please arrive at your specified time, as we will only be admitting one child's parents at a time, per class. Due to the present guidelines, we are not allowed to admit any siblings.
- If the weather permits we shall conduct these meetings outside, adhering to social distancing.
- We will ask that you sanitise your hands on entry to the playground.
- Current guidelines do not require any party to wear a face covering, if however you wish to do so, we are very happy for you to. If guidance changes, we will advise you accordingly. If you wear a mask and choose to remove it, please do so safely and put it into a plastic bag for re-use or to dispose of when you get home.

The object of this meeting is to catch up with you following the summer holidays and review the forms that you have already submitted to school. It will be an opportunity for you to ask any questions that you may have.

Starting school

To help your child transition into full time school, on both the induction day and the following week we will be finishing after lunch at 1pm.

The Induction Day provides the opportunity for your child to experience their new environment in a small group, and meet all of the Reception Staff. They will be able to explore the rooms, find new favourite toys and start to learn our routines.

The following week will be a continuation of this. By attending morning sessions and lunchtimes the children will be able to embed some of the routines and explore the setting more widely, before going full time the following week. We will then be able to offer a gradual transition into full time schooling.
