- I love reading and learning new things all the time



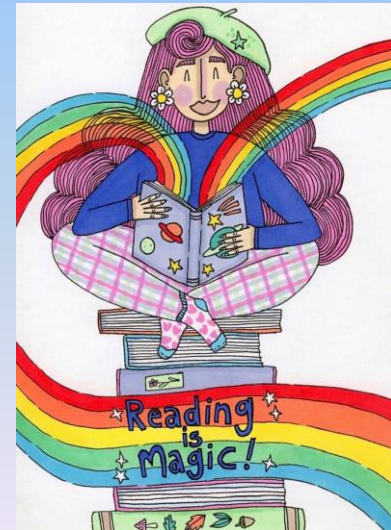


Miss Feather

- I like to keep active with dancing and yoga and I'm sure we can bring that into the classroom.

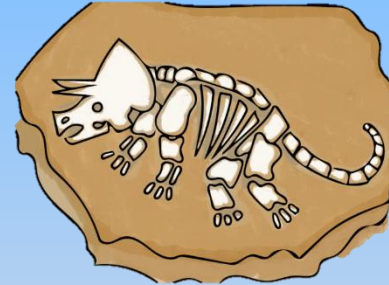


What is our First Topic?

- A break-time snack (fruit or veg)



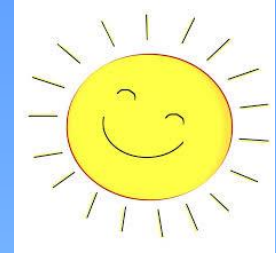
