It's All Greek to Me!

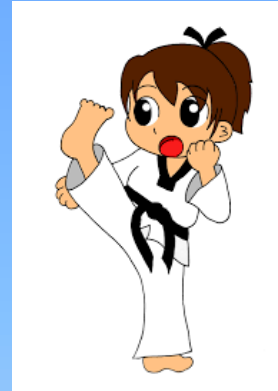
Another historical journey into what life was like in Ancient Greece.

What will I need?

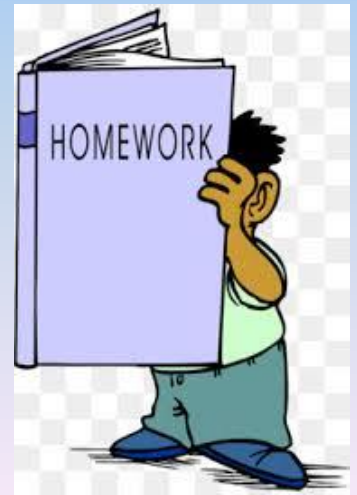
