What is our First Topic?



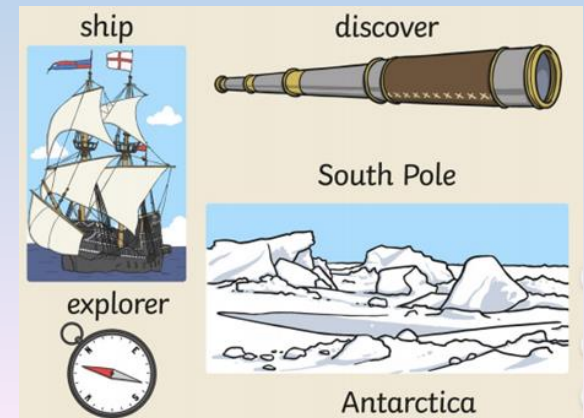
Amazing Africa
