Reading Books

We have recently benchmarked your child to ensure they are reading the appropriate challenging book. We will continue to do this regularly throughout the year.

Reading books are changed on a Monday and Thursday. If your child has finished their book between these dates then they can read a book from home or focus on tricky words in their current book. We do need their books in school each day so we are able to listen to them read.

Forest School

Homework

At the beginning of each term your child will receive a knowledge organiser for Science and Topic. They will get a 2 quizzes for each subject to complete at home.

They will get phonics homework weekly. It will be uploaded to seesaw on Friday and completed in their homework books ready for the Thursday.

On a Thursday, they will also get Maths homework. It will be uploaded onto see saw. This can also be completed in their homework books or on seesaw.

Please let your class teacher know if you are unable to access seesaw.

Phonics Screening test

 Due to Covid – 19, the children will be taking the phonic screening test they were due to take in Year 1, by the end of Autumn term. If they don't pass, they will retake it again in Summer.

 Each child will read 40 words. Some will be real words and some will be psuedo words (the children know these as alien words). Please let us know if we have more questions.
