SPELLINGS: Unstressed vowel sounds. Many words in the English language contain vowels that are not clearly pronounced. For example, in the word 'library' the middle vowel 'a' is usually not pronounced, meaning the word sounds like 'libry'. This results in the misspelling of words that contain unstressed vowels.
