READING: The school's expectation is that children will read with an adult at least three times a week however, in Key Stage One 'little and often' is the key to success and daily reading is preferable to develop fluency and confidence. 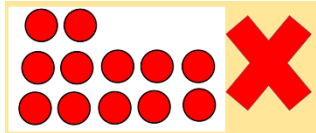
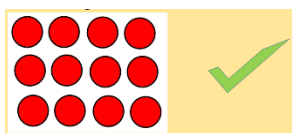


Image one is an array. Image two is not.
