

## Key Stage 1 BEHAVIOUR REWARDS AND CODES



### GOLD REWARDS

We want to celebrate your good behaviour with:

Head teacher's certificate      Stickers      Special privileges and activities  
Praise      House points      Special times

**If you choose to behave unacceptably you will receive a code:**

### CODE ORANGE

You will be given one verbal warning first. If you repeat it in a session you will be given a code orange which will be recorded.

This will be for any of the following:

- Calling out at the wrong time/ Interrupting
- Talking at the wrong time
- Making silly noises
- Not looking after equipment / resources
- Not working/participating in a group
- Interfering with other's learning
- Not being in the right place at the right time
- Ignoring any adult's instructions

**If you receive more than 2 code oranges in a lesson or repeat the code orange behaviour then you will be given a code blue.**

### CODE BLUE

**This is serious.** You will be given a code blue if you already have a code orange and repeat the same behaviour in a session. It will also be given for any of the following:

- Unkindness
- Name calling/ swearing or using inappropriate language or gestures
- Deliberately misusing property
- Answering back or speaking rudely to any adult
- Hurting others or being spiteful
- Goading/winding others up
- Refusing to follow adults instructions
- Stealing from others
- Not telling the truth
- Behaving in a dangerous way that could cause harm to others, deliberately or otherwise

**For each code blue, you will immediately have a 5 minute reflection time. You will fill out a 'code blue' incident form and a letter will be sent home to your parents.**

**If you get five code blues in a half term you will lose Golden Time Plus.**

### CODE PURPLE

**This is very serious.** You will have to work for at least a whole lesson in another class or area eg. Head's office. The head teacher and your parents will be informed. You will lose the following break and Golden Time Plus.

- Physical /threatening aggression/swearing to insult
- Intentional spitting and/ or biting
- Severely disrupting lessons
- Bullying

### CODE RED

**This is extremely serious.** The head teacher and your parents will be informed. It will lead to an internal exclusion and may lead to a suspension.

- Repeating code purple behaviour within a half term
- Planned violence /abuse/major theft/ vandalism/ racism/ persistent bullying/ homophobic language
- Child-on-child abuse
- Physical aggression or swearing towards any member of staff
