Friday 22nd May - Half term!

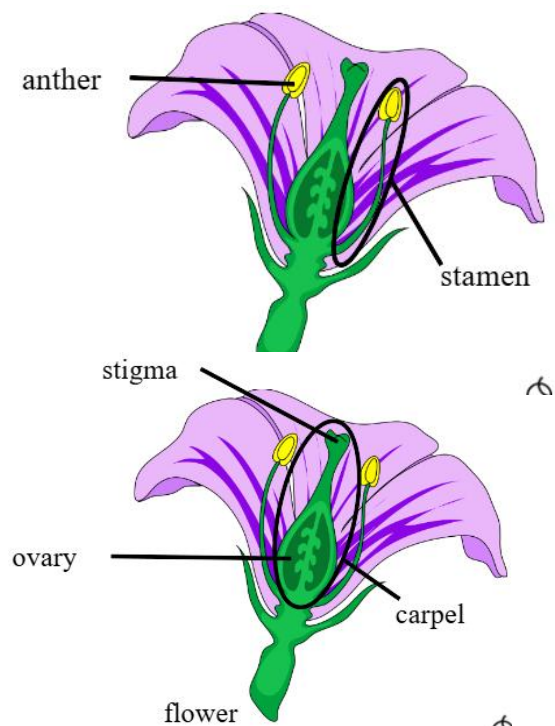

SPELLINGS: Please revise and learn the 100 spelling words. We are looking for improvements on the previous test. If needed, focus on sections rather than trying to learn them all. A copy of these words will be in the homework section. **Spelling test will be Friday 5th June.**

OPTIONAL EXTRAS - SCIENCE: we have been learning about reproduction in plants. Over the half term you could...

- Have a go at taking your own herb/other plant cutting (like we did in school). Remember to have permission and put the cutting in water to begin with.
- Look in your garden or a local outside area and see if you can identify the plants. When looking at flowering plants, can you find the following: anther, stamen, stigma, ovary, and any other parts you remember!
- Plant and monitor plants like tomatoes and strawberries.
- We will be learning about animal life cycles so you could research the life cycle of a mammal, bird, insect, or amphibian.
