

## Key Stage 2 BEHAVIOUR REWARDS AND CODES



### GOLD REWARDS

We want to celebrate your good behaviour with:

Celebration certificate	Stickers	Praise
Special privileges and activities	Special time	House points

If you choose to behave unacceptably you will receive a code:

### CODE ORANGE

You will be given a verbal warning first.

If you repeat it in a session you will be given a code orange which will be recorded.

This will be for any of the following:

- Calling out at the wrong time
- Talking at the wrong time
- Making silly noises
- Not working/participating in a group
- Interfering with other's learning
- Not being in the right place at the right time
- Interrupting
- Not handing in work/homework on time
- Not following/listening to adults instructions
- Not having the correct equipment for the lesson ie: ruler, PE kit

If you get three oranges in a week you will get a code orange strike lunchtime detention from 12.05-12.35. A letter will be sent home to your parents.

### CODE BLUE

This is serious. You will be given a code blue if you already have a code orange and repeat the same behaviour in a session. It will also be given for any of the following:

- Unkindness
- Name calling/ swearing or using inappropriate language
- Misusing property including damaging or defacing
- Answering back or speaking rudely to any adult
- Hurting others or being spiteful
- Goadng/winding others up
- Stealing from others
- Lying to deceive or cover up
- Deliberately ignoring any adult's instructions
- Showing defiance
- Behaving in a dangerous way that could cause harm to others, deliberately or otherwise

For each code blue, you will have a lunchtime detention from 12.05-12.35. A letter will be sent home to your parents.

If you get three code blues in a half term you will lose special times. You will also be put on a lunchtime or lesson time report card.

### CODE PURPLE

This is very serious. You will have to work for the whole lesson in another class. The head teacher and your parents will be informed. You will lose special times.

- Repeating code blue behaviour within the same week
- Posting threatening/abusive comments online or cyber bullying
- Physical/threatening aggression
- Severely disrupting lessons/bullying/swearing to insult/fighting/disrespecting adults

### CODE RED

This is extremely serious. The head teacher and your parents will be informed. It will lead to an internal exclusion and may lead to an external exclusion.

- Repeating code purple behaviour within a half term
- Planned violence /abuse/major theft/ vandalism/ racism/ persistent bullying/ persistent homophobic language
- Physical aggression or swearing towards any member of staff
